How to Make Learning Personal for Every Student

What am I supposed to do?

Centralize Learning Resources

It sounds so simple. But the answer is different for every assignment. In every class. Every day. That adds up to a lot of things to do. Sending or posting a detailed schedule of each day's activities, assignments, and readings with clear directions and submission requirements will help keep students on track and families informed.

When is it due?

Set Clear Expectations

Knowing when something is due is just as important as knowing what is due. If you are going to apply due dates to assignments, it's important to make sure there is clarity around when work should be completed and how it should be turned in.

3 How did I do?

Provide Personal Feedback

When you provide students feedback on assignments, graded or not, you are communicating to them that the learning process will continue and that you acknowledge their effort. Grades are inevitable. Make feedback personal and frame it as a learning opportunity.

Can you help me?

Establish Consistent Communication Methods

Communication processes will vary greatly from school to school and even classroom to classroom, but having clear methods for connecting with your students and their families is key.

What more can I do?

Present Learning Alternatives

Create additional and alternative opportunities for students to demonstrate understanding and that they are meeting expectations. Show that it doesn't always have to be done exactly one way.
