Document Sharing

Whether it's to somebody internal or to a client, Revver allows you to share your documents to anyone via a secured link. Rather than emailing your recipient the document itself, this link pulls them securely into Revver, giving them the proper amount of access with permissions control. That way it's always clear that you're working on the most current/latest version of that document. Plus, you'll always control their access with secure links that expire.

Similarly, users can initiate Document Requests to other users in or outside of Revver. This enables you to also get exactly what you need, and provides the person sharing the document with a secure way to get their information to you.

Document Check-In/Out

This is vital for making sure that changes/edits to documents aren't being overwritten when two people are working on it at the same time. When an item is checked-out, the document is still viewable to those with access, but they will be unable to upload a new version of the file until the current user checks it back in. And with File Versioning, once the new version is uploaded, Revver will still keep a copy of the original, so you'll always be able to check what changes were made and so that previous versions of the document can be restored if needed.

File Editing, Reviews, Approvals, and Signatures

Comment, Annotate, and Redact - Revver provides several feedback tools you can use to leave notes, draw, and blackout information. The preview toolbar provides you with everything you need to mark-up your documents for alterations that need to be made. Each action allows you to comment, leaving coworkers a reason for your alteration, and your mark-ups are all recorded in the version history. You can even use the Append/Prepend feature to combine new files to existing documents.
