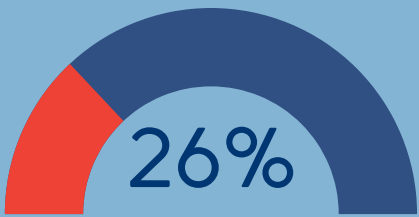

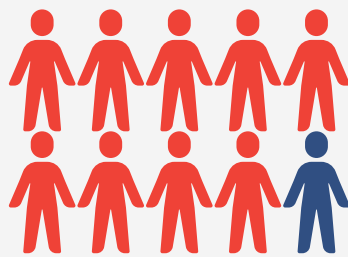


Saves Time

Employee Retention

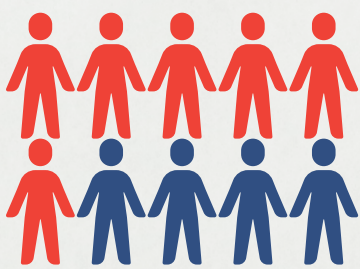
85% of employees surveyed (Gallup 2017) are frustrated with their jobs, and almost half surveyed want their organizations to invest in better technology.



Scalability

Nearly **60%** of employees feel they could save at least **6-8 hours** a week by automating manual, repetitive tasks



Organizational Knowledge



On average, it takes **42** days to train a replacement due to employee turnover. When a staff member leaves, they take their organizational knowledge with them. Putting a workflow process in place allows knowledge to be transferred to new staff members without disrupting operations. It is estimated (Mckinsey, 2017) that up to **one-third** of office procedures could be automated.

Fewer Errors, Less Risk

Studies have found that humans make more mistakes when doing repetitive tasks like data entry. Data entry errors is estimated at up to **40%** across multiple industries
